## **Programme:**

### Day 1 - Arrival in Venice

Arrival in Venice by own means. Accomodation at **Hotel Palazzo Giovanelli & Grand Canal 4\*Sup.** In the afternoon: walking through the Sestieri of San Polo and Dorsoduro to admire some architectural gems such as Basilica dei Frari, Campo Santa Margherita, Ponte Accademia, Campo Santo Stefano, Teatro La Fenice and Mozart's House. Dinner in a restaurant. Exclusive visit of the Basilica di San Marco at night. Return to the hotel.

#### Day 2 - Venice

### Day 3 - Venice and departure

Return to the hotel, farewell and departure by own means.
